

ITALIAN RIVIERA

1st day

PORTOFINO

Embark at Genoa and head to “le 5 Terre” area. After a stop for a walk in the charming fishermen village of Camogli, which lies amongst the mountains over the sea, spend the night in Portofino, the trendiest port in the Riviera. Have a cocktail in the famous Piazzetta Martiri, then an exclusive dinner by the hotel Splendido.



2nd day

PORTOVENERE

Stop in the morning at Portovenere, an ancient village in front of the little islands of Palmaria, Tino and Tinetto, three little islands of the Natural Park of le Cinque Terre. Very famous is the “path of the poets”, where P.B. Shelley and Lord Byron were used to promenade.



3rd day

VIAREGGIO - PISA

Moor in Viareggio, and make a trip to the incredible city of Pisa. This is a lovely town not far from the coast, very well known for the Leaning Tower in the Miracle’s Square. The tower, unique in the world, has been built during 2 centuries (XII and XIII), and started to incline during its construction.

4th and 5th days

CAPRI
